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## MEETING *rooms*

**Blue Room** **6-8 people**  
A less formal meeting room located on the lower level. It is a quiet space, arranged with two sofas and a table with chairs. It has an HD television and DVD player.

**Breakout Rooms** **4-6 people**  
These smaller meeting rooms are outfitted to handle small gatherings, or as secondary breakout spaces for larger meetings. Seating can be office or lounge style, with or without working tables in the room.

**Chapel Hall** **25-100 people**  
This is the largest meeting space that the Center offers. It is a versatile room, perfect for presentations, lectures, large board meetings, video conferencing or even smaller meetings where participants need more space. It easily converts to a place appropriate for worship.

**Collins Room** **10-30 people**  
The most popular meeting space at the Center, is located on the main floor. It is outfitted with a dry erase board and projection screen, and can be set up in a multitude of arrangements. It also offers access to the large private, covered, back patio and garden area.

**Dining Room** **5-50 people**  
The large downstairs dining room has seating for meals, as well as serving space including a heating table that will hold up to 4 full size catering trays. Coffee maker, plates, silverware, and dish service are included. There is no fee for the rental of the dining room if the Center provides meals for a meeting.

**Patio and Garden**  
Accessible through the Collins Room, the Center has a large private covered back patio and garden area; a perfect addition for a retreat day or activities involving youth.
