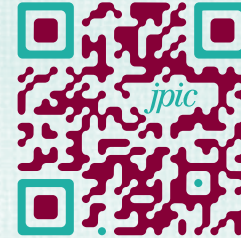

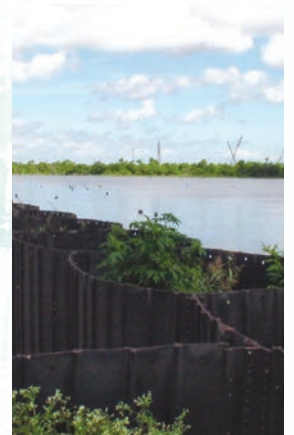
ABOUT US
